# **Ecosystem of statuses:** how are they connected? $\rightarrow$

EqHub comprises a large number of product registrations, which have accumulated over more than a decade.

To ensure the highest degrees of both transparency and traceability of our data, all current and historical statuses are available for our users.

Historical statuses simply refer to any status that is not currently used but which has been used at some point in time and may, therefore, still be present on certain product revisions.

# What is the meaning of each status? When should I use each of them?

### **Glossary / Terminology**





Status when the product revision can be edited.

Status when the product revision has been sent for verification and cannot be edited.

Status when the product revision has been sent for verification, approved and cannot be edited.

Status when the product Draft has been cancelled by the author/company super user before sending for verification.

Status when the product revision has been approved by the verifier according to Requirements (corresponding revision status is Published).

Status when the product revision has been sent for verification (corresponding revision status is Verification).

Status when the product revision has assigned verifier and verification is in progress (corresponding revision status is Verification).

Status when the product revision has been sent back to the author for rework by the assigned verifier (corresponding revision status is Draft).





# What is the meaning of each status? When should I use each of them?

### **Glossary / Terminology**







Status that indicates that a product revision verification is Draft, not in use.

Assigned through mass-import prior to, or without subsequent manual data entry process by data provider, not in use.

Requested by data provider for verification (pre-verification status).

Status indicates that a product revision has been through a verification process, not in use.

Submission of revision has been cancelled by a data provider, not in use.

Status used for information exchange to/from Virtual Inventory, not in use.
