## ILAP newsletter - December 2023

ILAP is now entering a new phase where the ILAP Data Exchange cloud service incrementally will be put into production. Initially with connectors to Safran and ILAP Analytics, which has been tested since August. Then follows SAP (PM) and Primavera (P6), which have been developed and are currently being tested.

Aker Solutions and Aibel, who have been central to the testing with Equinor, will be the first contractors to start using the new ILAP Data Exchange (IDE) cloud solution. Other contractors will be phased in over the spring.

The development of ILAP will continue with increased strength in 2024. Establishment of an organization for the development and operation of ILAP with representatives from all four operating companies is underway. The figure below outlines the ambition for the further development of ILAP.

We are now in the process of passing "Gap #1" by putting in place the foundations for stable operations and further development within Offshore Norway. During 2024, organizing ILAP *outside* Offshore Norway will be assessed. This is necessary for scaling ILAP beyond the Norwegian Continental Shelf (ref. "Gap#2" in the figure).

The ambition is to pass "Gap#2" by the beginning of 2025. Then ILAP will be made available to other operators as well as to contractors for use against their subcontractors.
